WOW what can I say! Axe Man V was an awesome and successful event. Thank you all for making it happen.

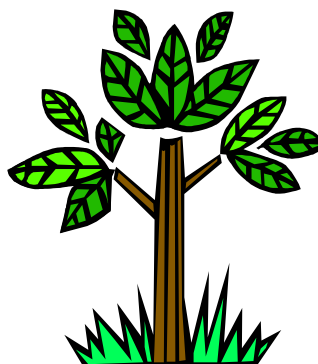
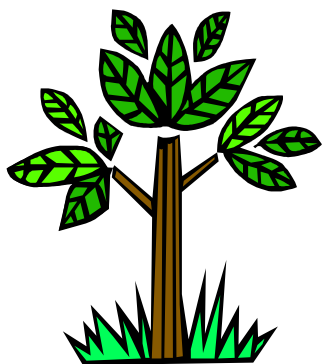

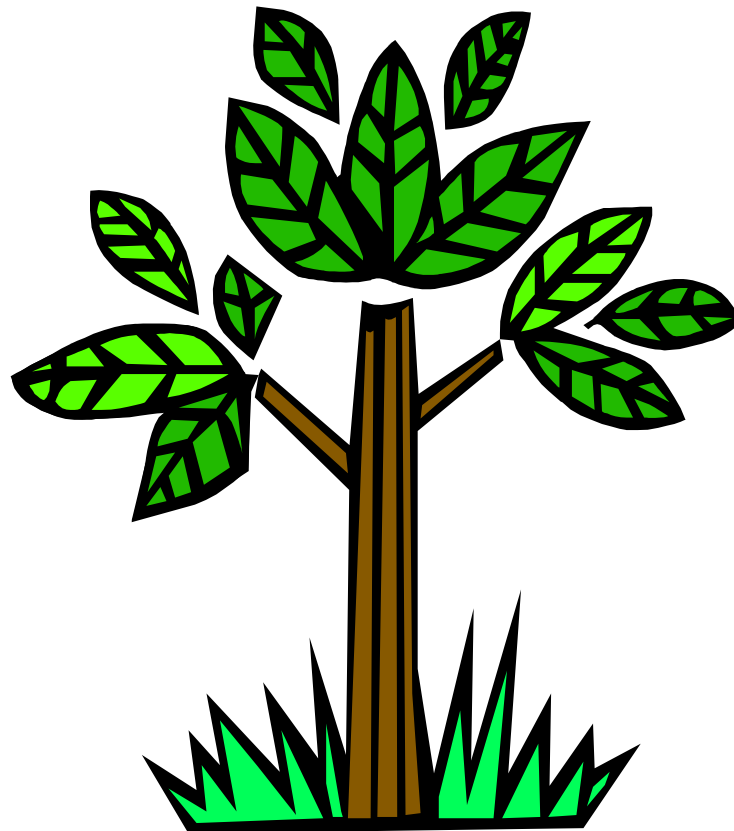
I hope everyone has a joyful holiday season and a Happy New Year! Our next meeting will be January 4, 2009!

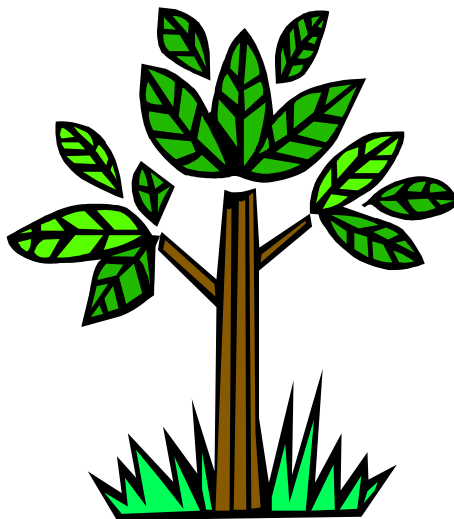

SAUSAGE WITH CABBAGE AND APPLES

- 2 TBSP CANOLA OIL (NEEDED)
- 2 PKGS COOKED SMOKED SAUSAGE OR KIELBASA (SLICED)
- 2 (16oz) BAG COLE SLAW MIX
- 3 MEDIUM APPLES, CORED, PEELLED, THINLY SLICED
- 2 CUPS CHICKEN BROTH
- 4 TBSP CEDAR VINEGAR
- 2 TSP SUGAR
- 1 TSP FENNEL SEEDS
- 1/2 TSP SALT

- 1.) HEAT LARGE SKILLET OR POT OVER MEDIUM-HIGH HEAT UNTIL HOT. ADD 2 TBSP OF THE OIL; HEAT UNTIL HOT. ADD SAUSAGE SLICES. COOK 3 TO 5 MINUTES OR UNTIL BROWN ON ALL SIDES. PLACE ON PLATE.
- 2.) HEAT REMAINING 2 TBSP OIL IN SAME SKILLET OR ~~POT~~ UNTIL HOT. ADD COLESLAW MIX. COOK AND STIR 3 MINUTES OR UNTIL IT BEGINS TO SOFTEN. STIR IN ALL REMAINING INGREDIENTS; COVER AND BRING TO A BOIL. REDUCE HEAT TO MEDIUM; SIMMER 10 TO 15 MINS OR UNTIL CABBAGE IS CRISP-TENDER. STIRREY OCCASIONALLY AND ADDING SAUSAGE DURING LAST 2 TO 3 MINUTES OF COOKING.

Games available will include: Period games, Monopoly, Risk, Uno, Card Games and various other board games.

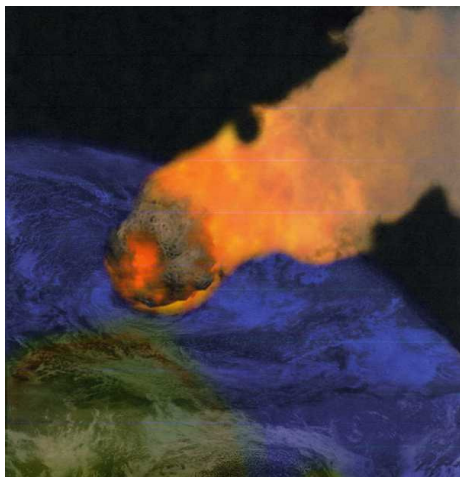
There will also be 2 traditional style role playing hosted (all characters are pre-generated and come with helpful guides for players who are unfamiliar with these games):
